- Age If this is posed as a question; I find it too irrelevant, as I don't evaluate people based on their age, more so on their revealed thoughts and actions. I think a person about to vote for someone to represent their interests also will not vote for someone based on their age.

- What civic committees and community volunteer work have you done?

I have done and continue doing volunteer activities in the community; as example, providing transportation for children's groups, being involved with youth and adult sports groups, mentoring youth to guide their principles, volunteering of services to local churches.

- What makes you stand out from other candidates?

A non-egotistical approach to ensure council is a resident taxpayer representation and all activities at city hall are according to the BC Community Charter! I represent municipal spending thrift and finding new sources of revenue that are not the resident taxpayer, to keep taxes lower!

- Do you believe that Port Coquitlam residents are getting good value for their tax dollars? Explain.
